City of Meridian Budget Workshops to be Streamed Live

MERIDIAN – The City of Meridian will be live streaming the first budget workshop meeting on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 from 8am to 5pm. At this meeting the Meridian City Council will meet with Mayor Tammy De Weerd and Department Directors to discuss proposed budget requests for Fiscal Year 2016 (FY16) which will begin on October 1.

“It’s very important to the City that we are transparent to the public and provide means for our residents to get involved in the budgeting process, whether in person or via a live stream,” said Mayor De Weerd.

Budget discussions will continue at a second budget workshop to be held on Tuesday, July 21. A tentative budget will be adopted Tuesday, July 28 and a public hearing is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, September 1 during which the FY16 budget will be formally adopted.
