MERIDIAN TO HOST LEGISLATIVE TOWN HALL

MERIDIAN – The City of Meridian will hold its fourth annual Legislative Town Hall on Wednesday, January 14, at 6:30 p.m. at Meridian City Hall. Assistant Majority Leader Senator Chuck Winder will be joined by other members of the House and Senate leadership as well as legislators from Meridian districts 14, 20, 21, and 22.

Lawmakers will hear presentations on issues important to the City of Meridian, the Meridian Chamber of Commerce, and the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council leaders. Meridian residents will also learn some of the issues lawmakers may be dealing with at the Statehouse this session.
