
## **City of Meridian Seeks Candidates for Planning and Zoning Commission**

MERIDIAN –The City of Meridian is accepting applications to fill a vacancy on the Planning and Zoning Commission. This five-person commission serves an advisory role to the Meridian City Council in matters relating to land use, zoning, transportation, and housing issues as framed by Meridian’s Comprehensive Plan.

Applicants for the current opening must be City of Meridian residents or reside in the city’s Area of City Impact. Applicants who live in the City will need to provide proof of residency in Ada County for two years and one year in the City prior to appointment. Applicants from the Area of City Impact need to show proof of residents in the County for two years. Meridian’s area of impact is identified as the unincorporated area in white on the attached map, within the dotted lines.

Commissioners are required to remain a resident in the area during the term of service (through February 28, 2020). The Planning and Zoning Commission meets the first and third Thursday of every month at 6:00 p.m. at Meridian City Hall. Members are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by a majority vote of the City Council.
