CITY OF MERIDIAN SEEKS TO FILL SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION VACANCY

MERIDIAN - The City of Meridian is seeking applications from Meridian citizens to fill a vacancy on the Solid Waste Advisory Commission. Interested candidates must submit applications by June 17, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. The preferred candidate will be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, and will serve the remainder of a three year term until September 30, 2017.

The Solid Waste Advisory Commission advises the Mayor and Meridian City Council on issues related to solid waste management and the co-mingled recycling program. The Commission meets monthly on the fourth Wednesday, at 4:00 p.m. at Meridian City Hall.

The Commission plays a vital role in determining the future of the community. Their efforts are crucial as they provide necessary input and assist the City with information gathering and deliberative processes.
