



Cart Placement Guide

- » Place carts at least 3 feet away from other carts or objects and 3 feet apart, on the curb
- » Give at least 14 feet clearance above cart from low branches
- » Make sure cart handle faces house
- » Place used motor oil in clear jugs and in view of drivers

Hazardous Waste Program

All hazardous materials should be taken to one of the Household Hazardous Waste collection events. This includes items such as: fluorescent tubes, paints and stains, electronics, oil and gasoline, automotive and lawn chemicals, and televisions 27" or smaller.

Trash Guidelines

- » Trash and recycling must be set out by 7am. Place carts 3 ft. from other carts and objects (fire hydrants, mailboxes, cars, utility poles) with the handle towards house. Make sure carts are in a safe and accessible location. Do not block sidewalks.
- » Residential trash rates in Meridian are based on the size of the trash cart. Call Meridian Utility Billing Services at (208) 888-4439 for current 32, 65 and 95 gallon trash cart rates.
- » All residents will receive a 95-gallon trash cart for automated pick-up (35- or 65-gallon carts available upon request).
- » Weight limits: 95-gallon carts - 330 lbs.; 65-gallon carts - 225 lbs; 32-gallon carts - 125 lbs.
- » Personal trash cans, boxes, bags, or loose items will not be serviced or collected (except the week after Christmas and during Spring Clean Up).
- » Trash service is unlimited the first full week after Christmas. Fill your cart first and place extra trash in trash cans for collection.
- » Additional carts are available for a small monthly fee. To order call Republic Services, (208) 345-1265, or email csidaho@republicservices.com
- » Place used motor oil in clear jugs visible to the driver on trash day (up to 2 gallons per week).

Bulky and Seasonal Waste

Residents can drop off trash, tires, wood, metal, construction debris and yard waste at the Republic Services Transfer Station for a fee. The Transfer Station is located at 2130 W. Franklin Rd. in Meridian.

Hazardous Waste & Prohibited Material

All hazardous materials should be taken to Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events held every Monday (except holidays) including: fluorescent tubes, CFL bulbs, paint, stain, varnish, computer monitors, televisions, tires, vehicle batteries, gasoline, oil, pesticides, and herbicides.

Prohibited Material

Explosives, ammunition, radioactive items, and biomedical waste are not accepted. DO NOT place loose sharps (needles, syringes, lancets) in trash or recycling bins. Meridian residents can come to Republic Services to receive a free sharps container. When container is full, bring it back to exchange for another. For information on proper disposal of prohibited materials call (208) 577-4736.

Spring Clean Up

Free pick-up of bulky items, non-freon appliances, tied wood bundles (4' or shorter, 60 lbs. or less), large paper yard waste bags and garbage in trash cans is offered during Spring Clean Up, the first full week of May each year. Call Republic Services to schedule bulky item or appliance collections.

Recycling Guidelines

- » Recycling pick-up occurs on your trash day, every other week. For collection dates visit the calendar online at local.republicservices.com/site/idaho and select Meridian in the Idaho Service Areas drop down menu.
- » All customers will receive a 95-gallon no sort recycling cart (32 or 65 gallon carts available upon request).
- » Recyclables should be empty, clean and dry. See list of acceptable recyclables below.
- » No glass, styrofoam, or yard waste in recycling cart.
- » Additional 95-gallon recycling carts are available for a small monthly fee.
- » Recycling must be loose in the cart — no plastic bags allowed.

Fall Leaf Recycling

Leaves may be recycled the first three full weeks of November. Leaves must be contained in large, compostable paper bags and placed curbside on service day.

Christmas Tree Recycling

Christmas trees are recycled the first full week in January. Cut trees and branches into 4ft pieces and place curbside on service day. Trees with lights, tinsel, ornaments, a stand, or flocked will not be accepted.

Grass Recycling

Grass recycling is an optional curbside service for Meridian residents. Subscribers receive a 95 or 48 gallon cart with tan lid. Collection will occur weekly on your regular trash day. Holiday Collection Schedule

Republic Services observes the following holidays:

- » New Year's Day
- » Memorial Day
- » Independence Day
- » Labor Day
- » Thanksgiving Day
- » Christmas Day

During holiday weeks, if your normal collection day falls on or after the holiday, your collection will be delayed by one day. Holidays falling on the weekend will not delay collection.

Carry-Out Service

Customers who have qualified for temporary or permanent disabilities under the Americans with Disabilities Act may receive free carry-out service. Other customers may sign up for carry-out service for an extra monthly charge. To order carry out service call Meridian Utility Billing Services (208) 888-4439.
