3:05	Kendall: Evidence Based Programs (EBP)	(Kendall) Please let us know if you are interested in co-teaching an Evidence Based Program (EBP), most likely CATCH My Breath (CMB) for parents. We are researching organizations that already offer EBPs to avoid duplication of efforts and identity possible partnership opportunities to expand existing EBPs. One of the places we reached out to is Family Advocates and we are scheduling a meeting to talk with them about their parenting classes. (Yoonwa) WASD is planning to start an Active Parenting class as part of a grant from Idaho Office of Drug Policy. The class is one of the approved curriculums through SAMHSA. It would be taught by one Drug Prevention Counselor (DPC) and two school counselors, offered in person or zoom. (Kendall) Doing great work with the DPCs and we'd love to do a debrief at the end of the school year to acknowledge what has worked well and areas for improvement. Did Idaho Office of Drug Policy train the DPCs to teach Active Parenting? (Yoonwa) No, there is a live webinar to guide us. WASD is going to do the 4 th edition class to start. (Kendall) We touched based with the Bridge regarding EBPs- good turnout for one class (10 people) and no one for the other. Also reached out to Boys & Girls club, YMCA, and Family Advocates. In the past there have been times where coalition members helped present with a staff member. If you hear of anyone or know of any programs, please let us know. (David) I was talking to the activity's director for a private school at Calvary Chapel. School is working on blending homeschoolers into a private school setting. Looking at a faith-based EBP. Parents are asking questions regarding EBPs, wanted to see if there is room or capacity maybe next school year? (Kendall) Operation Parent, has a great curriculum that is faith-based. (Kati) I brought books. (David) My brother is a pastor there; he wants the focus to be more real-life. A lot of kids just need a real conversation. I'll let you know if they want something more conventional. (Danielle) Idaho Department of Hea

Parenting with Love and Limits. (**Kendall**) As of now, we are looking at doing another Catch My Breath (CMB) class at Boys and Girls Club over the summer. If anyone has any ideas, please let us know. (**Kati**) Is this EBP inquiry specific to parents? (**Kendall**) It is specific to parents. I thought about recovery centers too, but I figured it would be too much. (**Kati**) CMB has the substance misuse lessons now. It costs \$99 a site. Hailey, do you have access to that? (**Hailey**) I'm not sure, I will have to check. (Upon checking, I do not have access). (**Kendall**) I'd have to look at it and see. CMB can be applied to other substances as well. I did look at HOPE, an evidence-based program that Heather at Central District Health recommended. We don't want to duplicate efforts or get trained and offer the class, and not have parents show up.

(**Kendall**) I got a proof to update the graphics on the trailer. The originals were more a scared straight approach. (David) Looks like Bonneville's car. (Robert) It looks like a license plate. (Hailey) It's more of like a focus, like a camera. (Danielle) I like it, more inviting. (Susie) It looks like an ice cream truck. (Kendall) If we are restricted on budget we won't do the front. Maybe putting a capsule along with the blue pills? (Robert) Maybe red or blue, something that stands out. Side note, is that Operation Parent book available for any parents? (Kati) Yes, but it's only hard copies, not online digitally. (Robert) I'd like some copies for the SRO team. Back to the trailer, I would like the logo and MADC/PD patch more symmetrical. (Kendall) Will have to double check and see if we can get some things moved around. (David) Maybe one side with hidden in plain sight, and our mission on the other. (Hailey) Maybe a QR code to our website? (Robert) MADC logo and the badge. Do we really need the hidden in plain sight on both? Maybe just one or the other. (Kati) Maybe with media, that you can post with it as a backdrop? (Hailey) Maybe a new Natural High backdrop? (Susie) I think the trailer should be blue. (Kendall) That would cost roughly \$3k and our budget is about \$1k. (Danielle) Have they checked out the trailer to make sure it's nice under the current wrap? (**Kendall**) Yes. (**Kati**) Original font instead of the current font. May attract people better. (Robert) If we need more money for the project, have you considered maybe cold calling some of the local companies that would want to sponsor it, or showing up to walk in? (Kendall) no but we could discuss that further if needed.
